

To get the complete list of all active, disconnected or idle terminal sessions available on selected computer(s) in a domain, instantly.



Any user with administrative can view and edit the password policy of his/her Domain


Allows administrator to edit the password policy set for any Domain in the network.



To get Domain Controller Specific Last Logon details.




